Re: Planned Waste Management for 305 American Boulevard West

Per City of Bloomington section (see below) to reduce the waste storage area required by Table 19.51.1, our planned waste management for the Avis/Budget building includes the following:

- Most of our files are paper and retained for corporate records, shipped to a secure document storage facility for shredding and disposal, and therefore do not generate much recyclables or waste.
- Our staff is limited to (2) persons, and the staff doesn't generate much recyclables or waste.
- The public does not use this facility for their recyclables or waste.
- Cleaning of cars involves vacuuming the interior and cleaning interior windows.
- Our recyclables consist of paper, debris left in vehicles, and minimal amounts of recyclable food packaging. Recycling sorting bins will be provided.
- Our waste mostly consists of minimal amounts of non-recyclable food packaging. Waste receptacles will be provided.
- We have eliminated all printed promotional materials throughout North America

- (e) Minimum storage area requirements.
- (1) Required solid waste storage and handling facilities shall provide minimum solid waste storage and handling capacity in accordance with the requirements identified in <u>Table 19.51.1</u>. Additional area shall be provided for recyclable material storage facilities in accordance with the minimum space requirements identified in the adopted Uniform Building Code. Any uses not identified will be based on similar uses described in the adopted Uniform Building Code. The minimum solid waste storage area identified in <u>Table 19.51.1</u> may be reduced up to 60% by incorporating a solid waste compacting device or a waste management plan as approved by the issuing authority.
