What is a station area plan?

The Station Area Plan is intended to help facilitate and improve transit use of the Bloomington South Transit Center, commonly referred to as the 98th Street Station. The City of Bloomington, in coordination with its partners, are looking to improve access to the station and invest in the station area to support the new METRO Orange Line Bus Rapid Transit.

What is the station area plan's vision?

Guiding the Station Area Plan are three overarching vision statements.

- Enhance the public realm to create a sense of place
- Improve access to the station for all users
- Promote development patterns that support transit

Orange Line Improvements Include:

- 17-mile transitway connecting Burnsville, Bloomington, Richfield, and Downtown Minneapolis
- 12 transit stations with enhanced amenities
- All-day, reliable, frequent service, 7 days a week
- Accessibility and pedestrian improvements

What is Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)?

- Frequent Service frequent enough you don't need a schedule
- Train-like Features -pay fare before boarding
- Enhanced Stations real time departure signs, enhanced maps
- Enhanced Security cameras, emergency phones, improved lighting
- Specialized Vehicles wider aisles and more doors

Previously Planned Improvements

Station - Metro Transit will add bus rapid transit platforms and improve the transit center with enhanced seating, landscaping, improved crossings and intersection improvements.

Street Trees - This project includes the replacement of Ash trees and associated tree grates along 98th Street and Lyndale Ave in the station area. The grates will be replaced with planting beds that will widen the walkway.

Bike Lanes - The City will continue the existing bike lanes on Lyndale Ave up to 99th Street. It is also adding a multi-use trail along the East Bloomington Freeway frontage road. These bicycle facilities connect to the Minnesota River Valley.




Infrastructure Improvements

Over 30 areas are identified for improvements in the Station Area Plan. Improvements focus on increasing pedestrian and bicycle access to the transit station. A few recommendations include:

- · Improving crossings with refuge islands
- lengthening signal time
- adding accessible pedestrian signals

Some recommendations are smaller in scope and can be completed in the near term. Larger recommendations will require additional study. The specific recommendations can be found on the project website at:

Corridor/ Interchange Study

Many of the infrastructure improvements recommended will require further study and modeling. A corridor/ interchange study will:

- Conduct the traffic modeling necessary for any roadway modifications
- Evaluate potential improvements through the lens of safety and pedestrian access
- Address transportation pattern changes as a result of the METRO Orange Line and other redevelopment



Rezoninc

The station area underwent major redevelopment in the 1980's. The area has many large underutilized parking lots. The plan recommends upzoning key parcels near the station to B-4 Neighborhood Commercial Center to allow for mixed use redevelopment and promote pedestrian friendly site design.

Coordination of Implementation

The recommendations will require coordinated cooperation among agencies and private entities alike. Metro Transit operates the transit system, Hennepin County has jurisdiction over 98th Street, and the interchange is under MnDOT jurisdiction. Additionally, redevelopment of private property will greatly impact how well the area functions.
