- 1) Parking for the health club is 1 space per 250 square feet. The required parking is 10 spaces. Required parking for the health club would be less than a retail use in the same tenant space.
- 2) Identify the existing trash facilities on a plan. Any change of use requires compliance with Code for indoor trash.
- 3) Signage to comply with the City Code and the Uniform Sign Design on file.
- 4) Review of the landscaping plan on file shows that many of the required trees and shrubs were removed. With the conditional use permit, the missing material must be replanted and a landscaping plan must be submitted prior to building permit issuance. The approved plan is available on the portal.
- 5) Parking lot lighting is compliant. No upgrades needed at this time.
- 6) The next deadline for submittal is Wednesday, August 5th by 2pm. This would bring the item to the September 10th Planning Commission meeting.

- 5) Restroom must meet fixture count per 2020 MN Building Code Chapter 29. Must also meet 2020 MN Accessibility Code.
