## STORMWATER POND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

This Agreement for maintenance of a stormwater pond is made this <u>9th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 2020 by <u>Pirst Industrial</u>, <u>L.P.</u> the owner (the "Owner") of Lot 1, Block 2, <u>Nesbitt Industrial Park</u>, Hennepin County, Minnesota (the "Property").

The Owner's approved stormwater management plan for handling stormwater on the Property contemplates in part the installation and operation of three (3) stormwater ponds on the Property.

This Agreement is given to evidence the Owner's promises and representations with respect to the maintenance of that stormwater treatment system.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Owner agrees to:

- 1. Check the outlet structure regularly for clogging and clean and/or repair as necessary.
- Check banks and bottom surface of basin for crosion and correct as necessary.
- 3. Check and clean the facility of accumulated debris at least biannually and after each extreme storm events. Check the banks of surface ponds and repair areas of erosion. Remove nuisance wetland species and take appropriate measures to control mosquitoes.
- 4. Remove sediment, floatables and debris from inlets, outlets and skimmers.
- 5. Trim or harvest pond vegetation as appropriate; frequently mowing grassy areas. Grass should be mowed so that it does not exceed 6-inches.
- Remove sediment when accumulation reaches 6-inches, or if re-suspension is observed or probable.
- 7. If removed sediment contains contaminants, remove using special disposal methods, as appropriate.
- 8. Allow city staff to conduct inspections of stormwater BMPs as necessary. Stormwater ponds not functioning properly due to improper maintenance may be considered a property condition constituting a public nuisance.
- 9. Keep a plan identifying pond maintenance instructions on the site and a log listing the dates of maintenance and condition of the pond at the time of maintenance. A copy of the maintenance log and proposed maintenance instructions shall be provided to the City of Bloomington Engineering Division upon request.




