Otherwise, the construction will be considered as installed without proper approval. A separate correspondence will be issued for changes or addenda.

INSPECTIONS: It is the responsibility of the owner or owner's agent to contact the MDH for any inspections that are listed in the requirements of this report.

This project consists of the installation of 680 lineal feet of 6-inch ductile iron watermain.

## Requirement(s):

1. It is understood that the installation will be in accordance with previously approved City Engineers Association of Minnesota Watermain Specifications, 2013 edition.

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The approval for construction of this project is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter. If project construction has not begun within the two-year period, plans and specifications must be resubmitted to MDH for approval before any construction takes place. While the project has been approved, additional recommendations or requirements may be made to the project when changed conditions, additional information, or advanced knowledge make improvements necessary.
