Airport Zoning Permit – SICK Phase I

Mr. McGinty:

As required by the MSP International Airport Zoning Ordinance, you submitted an application for an Airport Zoning Permit to construct Phase I of a multi-phase technology campus at 2501, 2601, and 2701 American Blvd. E. On May 3, 2021, the City Council approved preliminary and final development plans for the SICK technology Campus (Case PL2021-44). On August 31, 2020, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) issued Determinations of No Hazard to Air Navigation for the Phase I technology campus building and temporary construction crane. On May 3, 2021, the Metropolitan Airports Commission (MAC) approved a variance to height restrictions for the temporary construction crane.

Acting as Airport Zoning Administrator for Bloomington, today I approve Airport Zoning Permits for Phase I of the technology campus and temporary construction crane.
