- 1) A sign permit will be required for modifications to the existing sign, including face changes. Noted.
- 2) Ground cover within the dog run should be something other than turf due to the impact of waste. Ground cover within the dog park shall be mulch, as noted in the Landscape Plan.
- 3) Add sidewalk dimension. Minimum width of the private sidewalk is 5' clear. Sidewalks have been dimensioned and private sidewalks are at least 5' in width. Concrete near NW Bike racks and drive aisle will not be utilized as sidewalk. 5' Clear provided at all other locations.
- Add bike rack detail to plan sheet.
 Bike rack detail to be provided by Architect.
- 5) Ensure 5-feet clear walking width is maintained adjacent to bike rack. Note added to Site Plan (see Note 3).

1) Ensure landscaping/fencing doesn't interfere with access to the building, hydrants and/or FDC.

Confirmed that the fencing does not conflict with these items.

- 1) Any closure of the public sidewalk will require a ROW permit and will need to be coordinated with the other projects occurring in the area

- 2) Retaining walls 4 ft in height or higher must be designed by a professional engineer and require a

separate building permit.

No retaining walls are more than 4 ft height, however note added to plans.
