Mr. Johnson and Planning Commission Members,

Please consider this letter as the Minneapolis Regional Chamber's comments on the proposed ordinance amending sign regulations in Bloomington.

We appreciate the input that city staff has solicited about this ordinance from the business community. From these conversations, we understand the city's goal is to update and standardize the language in the ordinance. The current language of the proposed ordinance recommends 10-minute dwell times for digital billboards. A duration that is longer than those in surrounding communities, including the Metropolitan Airports Commission.

The Minneapolis Regional Chamber urges the commission to consider the nationwide standard of 8 second dwell times, supported by Federal Highway Administration safety research, and aligns with most municipalities in the region.
