Conditional Use Permit for Chuck & Don's Pet Food & Supplies Project Description

To whom it may concern:

Chuck & Don's in Bloomington is expanding their retail space into the unit next to the existing store. In this new space they are including grooming and self-wash services. There is room for six clipping tables and two self-wash tubs. There is also a bank of kennels to house the animals while they are going through the grooming process. The animal is washed, given an initial blow dry, and then placed in a kennel where a fan blows cool air directly on them to finish the drying process. Then they receive their hair cut and are placed back into the kennel while they wait for their owner to pick them up.

Our architect is working on creating a sound buffer between the new unit and the neighboring tenant. Per code we will meet or exceed the STC rating of 55.

Our practice has always been to sanitize and clean tubs/tables and kennels between each dog. Covid-19 heightened the awareness around how important this is to prevent any transference between animals and humans. All the steps we take also help to mitigate any potential odor issues.
