Dear Mike,

Here is a site diagram showing the proposed portable location. We have some flexibility about the exact location, but this is the location that we would like to locate them.

Narrative:

Bloomington Public Schools is studying the relocation of 4 of their portable classrooms to the Hillcrest Elementary site. This is to accommodate an enrollment increase at this building due to some configuration changes the District is considering. The classrooms would be installed in a manner similar to the ones that had been located at other sites in recent years for construction. This would include a link to the main building for weather controlled access and access to toilet facilities. The classrooms would be located at Hillcrest for up to 3 years. If the District requires capacity beyond 3 years they would likely build a permanent addition to address the need. The portables would include 4 classrooms that would accommodate up to approximately 100 students. The portables and link would be approximately 4,100sf.
